Architect, Professor of Architectural Projects Superior Technical School of Architecture Granada, Spain Elisa Valero Ramos constructed work has been awarded in Italy, France, Switzerland and Spain and widely published in books and magazines.

She has been a visiting professor in more than twenty-five schools in Europe and America and the author of a dozen books, including "The theory of the diamond and the architectural project" (published in Spain, Italy and France) and "Light in Architecture, the Intangible Material" (with three editions in Spain and one in the United Kingdom).

In 2012 she obtained the chair of architectural projects at the University of Granada, where she directs a research group aimed at developing low-cost, low-energy construction systems. Convinced of the urgent need to respect nature, she explores new paths for architecture that have earned her the Swiss Architectural Award in 2018 and the Andalusia Architecture Prize in the innovation and construction category in 2022.
