



Jenny Roe is an environmental psychologist and former head of Landscape Architecture for an international architectural practice.

She specializes in restorative environments that support mental health, emphasizing the importance of public parks and urban green spaces. Her influential work includes *Restorative Cities: Urban Design for Mental Health and Wellbeing* (Roe and McCay, 2021), advocating for mental health-centered urban design, and the forthcoming *Restorative Architecture: The Science of Design for Mental Health and Wellbeing* (Bloomsbury, 2027).

Roe's extensive research encompasses architectural and landscape contexts and their psychological impacts, resulting in over fifty-five peer-reviewed publications, including for the World Health Organization and *The Lancet*.
