

TONINO GRIFFERO

Full professor of Aesthetics University of Rome "Tor Vergata", Italy Tonino Griffero is a full professor of Aesthetics at the Tor Vergata University of Rome, where he also directs several academic series and the e-journal "Lebenswelt." His scholarly work is expansive, covering hermeneutics, German idealism, and the philosophy of symbol and mythology. He specializes in aesthetics and phenomenology of atmospheres, exploring the ontology of quasi-things and the philosophy of the lived body.

Griffero has authored numerous influential books, including Atmosferologia: Estetica degli spazi emozionali (2010), translated as Atmospheres: Aesthetics of Emotional Spaces (2014), and Quasicose: La realtà dei sentimenti (2013), translated as Quasi-Things: The Paradigm of Atmospheres (2017).

His upcoming work, Being a Lived Body, is set to be published in 2024, continuing his exploration of neo-phenomenological perspectives.
